



School Litter Analysis Critical Thinking Questions

Students can work independently to answer the following questions or discuss with a small group and take notes to then share with the class.

1. After conducting your on-campus cleanup, how would you rank your school in terms of cleanliness? Circle one choice below:

No litter Slightly littered Littered Extremely littered

Minimal or No litter = virtually no litter can be observed.

Slightly littered = a small amount of litter is observed.

Littered = visible litter is easily seen throughout the area.

Extremely littered = a continuous amount of litter is observed, some large enough to require equipment or extra manpower to remove (e.g. appliances, construction debris, abandoned vehicles, etc.).

- 2. Were there specific areas on campus with much more litter? Why do you think there is more litter in those areas?
- 3. What items did you notice most often littered at your school?
- 4. Who do you think is doing the littering? Why do you think they are littering?
- 5. Did you notice trash and recycling bins on campus? Were they easy to spot?
- 6. What do you think can be done to reduce litter on campus?
